- Once called, each speaker has up to 1 ½ minutes at the discretion of the Commission President. Depending on the number of speakers, the time limit may be reduced to 1 minute.
- A bell will ring when time has expired.
- At the end of the telephonic Public Comment Section, the Commission President will ask the Public Advisor if there are any email commenters. The Public Advisor will read any email comments, time permitting.

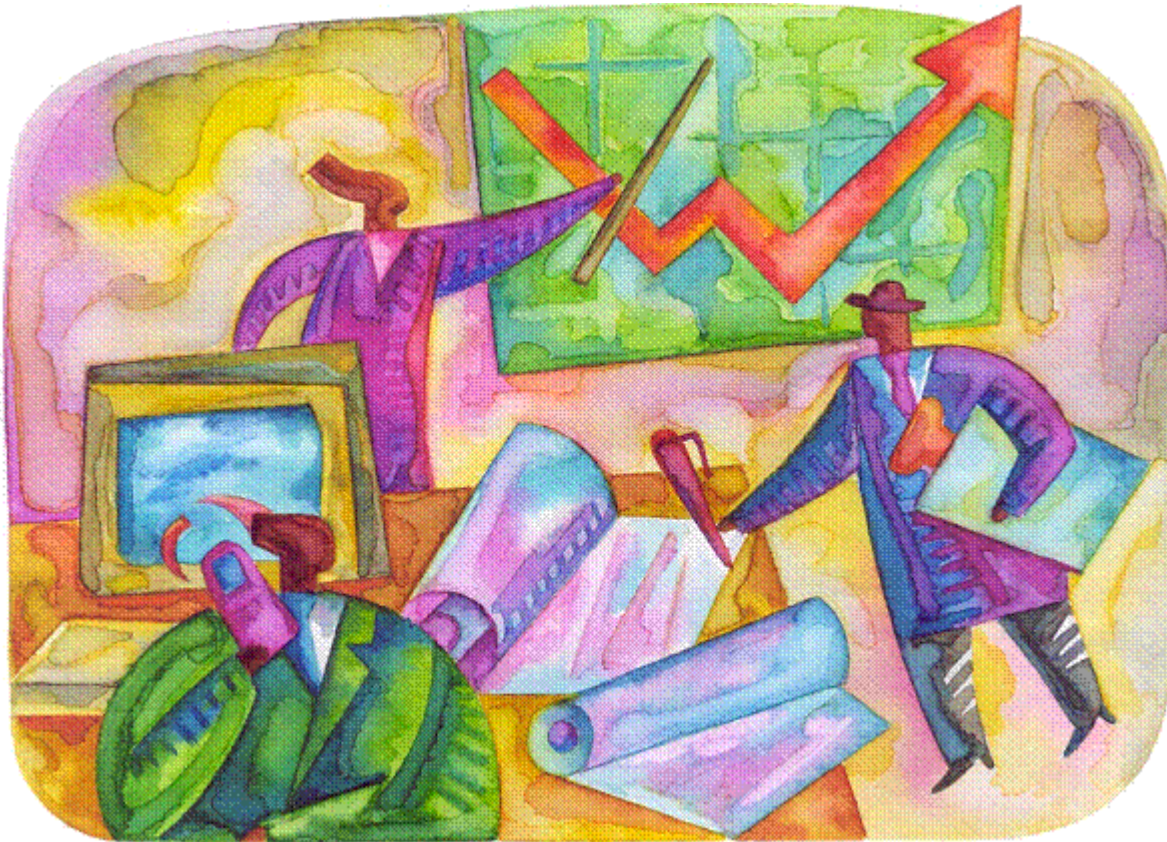
# Regular Agenda
